AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DANBURY, TEXAS, OFFERING A REWARD OF \$ FOR THE ARREST AND CONVICTION OF ANY PERSON OR PERSONS FOUND GUILTY OF
COMMITTING THE CRIME OF ARSON WITHIN THE CORPORATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY TEXAS:	COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DANBURY,
Section 1: From and after the ef	ffective date of this ordinance the City of
Danbury, Texas, does hereby offer a	reward of \$ for the arrest
and conviction of any person or person	as found guilty of committing the crime of
arson, as such crime is defined in Ve	rnon's Penal Code of the State of Texas,
Articles 1304 and 1305, within the cor	porate limits of said City of Danbury,
Texas. This reward is a standing offer	er and same shall be paid out of the
Fund of said city.	
Section 2: Should any section or	part of this ordinance be held unconstitutional
illegal or invalid, such unconstitutions	ality, illegality, or invalidity of such section
or part shall in no wise affect, impair	, or invalidate the remaining portion there-
of, but as to such remaining portion th	ne same shall be and remain in full force
and effect.	
Section 3: All ordinances or par	ets of ordinances in conflict herewith are
hereby expressly repealed.
