ORDINANCE NO. 12

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DANBURY, TEXAS, OFFERING A REWARD OF \$ _____ FOR THE ARREST AND CONVICTION OF ANY PERSON OR PERSONS FOUND GUILTY OF COMMITTING THE CRIME OF ARSON WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF SAID CITY; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DANBURY, TEXAS:

Section 1: From and after the effective date of this ordinance the City of Danbury, Texas, does hereby offer a reward of \$ _____ for the arrest and conviction of any person or persons found guilty of committing the crime of arson, as such crime is defined in Vernon's Penal Code of the State of Texas, Articles 1304 and 1305, within the corporate limits of said City of Danbury, Texas. This reward is a standing offer and same shall be paid out of the _____ Fund of said city.

Section 2: Should any section or part of this ordinance be held unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity of such section or part shall in no wise affect, impair, or invalidate the remaining portion thereof, but as to such remaining portion the same shall be and remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.
