ORDINANCE NO. 19

AN ORDINANCE VACATING, ABANDONING AND CLOSING AVENUE C FROM SEVENTH STREET NORTH TO THE CITY LIMITS; AVENUE D FROM EIGHTH STREET NORTH TO THE CITY LIMITS; NINTH STREET FROM MAIN STREET EAST TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF BLOCK 99; AND EIGHTH STREET FROM AVENUE D EAST TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF BLOCK 95, IN THE CITY OF DANBURY, TEXAS, "SUSPENDING THE RULE REQUIRING ORDINANCES TO BE READ UPON THREE SEPARATE DAYS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, A. E. Novak holds the legal title to and is the owner of all the real property abutting on both sides of the streets, according to the map or plat of the City of Danbury, Texas; and

WHEREAS, A. E. Novak, as the only abutting owner has petitioned the City Council of the City of Danbury, Texas, to vacate, abandon and close the hereinafter described streets for the reason that the same interferes with and is needed by the said A. E. Novak for the development of his property; and

WHEREAS, said streets have never been used as a passage way by the public; and

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DANBURY, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the portions of the streets hereinafter described, be vacated, abandoned and closed to the general public, and vacated, abandoned and closed to vehicular traffic and traffic of all kinds and that same be permanently vacated, abandoned and closed.

Section 2. The description of the portions of the streets which by this ordinance is vacated, abandoned and closed is described as follows:

Avenue C from Seventh Street North to the city limits;
Avenue D from Eighth Street North to the city limits;
Avenue E from Eighth Street North to the city limits;

Ninth Street from Main Street East to the Northeast corner
of Block 99;
Eighth Street from Avenue D East to the Northeast corner
of Block 95.

Section 3. Any rule requiring the reading of this Ordinance on three
separate days is hereby suspended.

Section 4. WHEREAS, the streets prevent the proper use and develop-
ment of his abutting properties, and emergency is created in behalf of the
public peace, health, safety and general welfare, necessitating that this
Ordinance become effective at once and it is accordingly ordained that this
Ordinance become effective immediately upon its passage and shall take effect
and be in force from its passage.
