ORDINANCE NO. 22-07

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DANBURY, TEXAS, APPPOINTING JOHN VASUT AS MUNICIPAL JUDGE, APPROVING A COMPENSATION AGREEMENT PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 29 OF THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE WITH JOHN VASUT TO PERFORM SERVICES AS THE MUNICIPAL JUDGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DANBURY, TEXAS, DULY ASSEMBLED:

- 1. The City Council of the town of Danbury has determined that a Municipal Judge of Danbury is necessary to perform the judicial functions in the Town of Danbury.
- 2. The City Council of the Town of Danbury has determined that John Vasut should be appointed as Municipal Judge of Danbury.
- 3. The City Council of the Town of Danbury has determined that an agreement should be entered into with John Vasut to perform services as Municipal Judge of Danbury.
- 4. The City Council of the Town of Danbury herby appoints John Vasut as Municipal Judge of Danbury for a two-year term, which term shall begin on July 7th and shall end on July 1th 2024. John Vasut may not serve beyond the said term except upon the express authority of the City Council, and this provision shall control over any law, rule or regulation in conflict herewith.
- 5. The compensation agreement by and between the City of Danbury and John Vasut regarding his services as Municipal Judge of Danbury, setting the rate at \$30.00 per hour pursuant to Chapter 29 of the Texas Government Code.
- 6. If any part of this ordinance, of whatever size, is ever declared invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of this order shall remain in full force and effect.
- 7. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
