ORDINANCE NO. 22-08

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DANBURY, TEXAS, APPPOINTING RICHARD DAVIS AS ALTERNATE JUDGE, APPROVING A COMPENSATION AGREEMENT PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 29 OF THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE WITH RICHARD DAVIS TO PERFORM SERVICES AS THE ALTERNATE JUDGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DANBURY, TEXAS, DULY ASSEMBLED:

- 1. The City Council of the town of Danbury has determined that an Alternate Judge of Danbury is necessary to perform the judicial functions in the Town of Danbury.
- 2. The City Council of the Town of Danbury has determined that Richard Davis should be appointed as Alternate Judge of Danbury.
- 3. The City Council of the Town of Danbury has determined that an agreement should be entered into with Richard Davis to perform services as an Alternate Judge of Danbury.
- 4. The City Council of the Town of Danbury herby appoints Richard Davis as an Alternate Judge of Danbury for a two-year term, which term shall begin on July 7 2024 and shall end on July 7 2024. Richard Davis may not serve beyond the said term except upon the express authority of the City Council, and this provision shall control over any law, rule or regulation in conflict herewith.
- 5. The compensation agreement by and between the City of Danbury and Richard Davis regarding his services as an Alternate Judge of Danbury, setting the rate at \$30.00 per hour pursuant to Chapter 29 of the Texas Government Code.
- 6. If any part of this ordinance, of whatever size, is ever declared invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of this order shall remain in full force and effect.
- 7. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
