AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND ACCEPTING THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE
28, OF THE REVISED CIVIL STATUTES OF TEXAS 1925, RELATING
TO CITIES AND TOWNS

WHEREAS, The Board of Aldermen of the Town of Danbury is
desirous of adopting and accepting the provisions of Title 28 of the
Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, relating to cities and towns; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Danbury contains more than 600 inhabi-
tants and/or contains one or more manufacturing establishments within
the corporate limits, now therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF DANBURY, TEXAS:

Section 1. The provisions of Title 28 of the Revised Civil Statutes
of Texas, 1925, relating to cities and towns, is hereby
adopted and accepted.

Section 2. The Town of Danbury shall hereafter be known as the City
of Danbury, Texas.

Section 3. The Town Secretary of the Town of Danbury, be directed to
enter this ordinance upon the journal of minutes of the
Board of Aldermen, and a copy of same, signed by the Mayor,
and Attested by the Secretary under the corporation seal,
shall be filed and recorded in the Office of the County
Clerk of Brazoria County, Texas.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its
passage and approval.
