

ORDINANCE NO. 67A

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DANBURY, TEXAS, TO INCLUDE ALL LANDS AND AREA WITHIN CERTAIN LIMITS AND BOUNDARIES AND ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF DANBURY ALL OF THE AREA WITHIN SUCH LIMITS AND BOUNDARIES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Danbury has heretofore announced its intention to annex certain land to the City; and

WHEREAS, on May 15, 1975, a public hearing was held at which all interested persons were given the opportunity to appear and be heard on the proposed annexation; therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DANBURY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: The boundaries and limits of the City of Danbury are hereby extended so as to embrace and include the following described area of land, and the following described area of land is hereby annexed to and made a part of the City of Danbury, to-wit:

A 13.88 acre tract out of Tracts 85 & 86 of the South Texas Development Company Subdivision of the Henry Austin Survey, 4, Abstract 12, Brazoria County, Texas, and by metes and bounds described as follows:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the Northeast line of tract 85 and the existing City Limits Line of Danbury, Texas;

THENCE South 27 deg. East 420.08 feet along the East line of tract 85, continuing along the East line of Tract 86 to a total distance of 533.17 feet to a point for corner;

THENCE South 42 deg. 41' West 1209.89 feet to a point for corner;


THENCE North 27 deg. West 533.17 feet to a point for corner;

THENCE North 42 deg. 41' East 1209.89 feet along the existing Danbury City Limits Line to the Place of Beginning.

Said tract therein containing 13.88 acres of land.


SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
